Health4TheWorld is a non-profit organization founded in 2016 in California by Bhavya Rehani and William Dillon, neuroradiologists, and Ankur Bharija, a specialist in education, geriatrics and global health. This foundation seeks to provide a selfless service in healthcare to help people around the world-particularly those in countries where healthcare resources and technology are deficient-through sustainable solutions that provide training and education to physicians and healthcare professionals, as well as solutions for patients, through and patient solutions, such as a mobile stroke app for patients.

The entire team is made up of doctors, nurses and therapists from at least 15 leading academic health institutions in the United States, in the U.S., in conjunction with systems engineers, filmmakers, film editors, marketing professionals film editors, marketing professionals, translators, physicians and patients in countries around the world.

Bhavya Rehani is from India, and her inspiration for creating the organization was born out of her personal experiences in her family and in her country, where health deficiencies have affected the lives of many people. At November 2020, she participated as one of the keynote speakers at the North American the Radiological Society of North America (RSNA) Congress.

Currently, Health4TheWorld has a large platform and YouTube channel where you can find free radiology lectures in all subspecialties and also in other areas of medicine, such as neurology, pediatrics, geriatrics, oncology, OB/GYN, internal medicine and infectious diseases, along with a group of lectures on COVID and also the Resident's Corner. The main language is English, but there are also lectures in Spanish, French, Nepali Chinese and Swahili.

The organization promotes the formation of chapters that contribute to its cause and are made up of physicians, academics, universities and health organizations.

There are currently 18 international chapters and 21 chapters in the United States.

We came up with the idea of forming a chapter that today is a reality and is called the Asociación Colombiana de Radiología Chapter. Dr. Juan Pablo Ovalle, a neuroradiologist, has been the main leader of the Colombian chapter, which also includes Dr. Micaela Arrieta, as president and representative of the Colombian Association of Radiology; Dr. María Lucía Brun, a senior resident in radiology at Universidad El Bosque; Dr. Jenny Bencardino, a Colombian radiologist, head of Musculoskeletal Imaging at the University of Pennsylvania, and myself. of Pennsylvania, and myself.
